



Cleaning Checklist for Covid-19

This is by no means a complete list of what and how your summer rental home should be cleaned, but rather a start for you to help guide your cleaning service this summer.

- ✓ Ventilate rooms before you clean. Allow some fresh air to circulate, 20 minutes would be great, but if not, at least where you feel the air has been changed out.
- ✓ Wash hands thoroughly before and after each cleaning job.
- ✓ Wear disposable gloves that can be thrown out after each cleaning.
- ✓ Leave shoes at the door or wear construction booties.
- ✓ Have plenty of disposable cleaning supplies, paper towels and disinfectant wipes.
- ✓ Clean first, then disinfect.
- ✓ Use the right disinfectant – cleaning products with at least 70% alcohol.
- ✓ Start with a clean vacuum cleaner. Dispose of last job at the last job.
- ✓ Focus on frequently touched surfaces.

These surfaces should include:

Light switches, doorknobs, railings, counters, faucets, sinks, cabinet pulls and handles, thermostats and remotes.
